## **LOCATION & DATES:**

CLARION HOTEL AT THE PALACE, BRANSON, MISSOURI OCT. 25 - 28, 2006 Room rate is \$74 + tax. (Three days before/after same rate.) Check-in time is after 2:00 pm and check-out time is 11:00 am. Guests who vacate their room after 11:00 am and prior to 4:00 pm will be charges a half day rate equal to half the room rate that they are paying. Guests checking out after 4:00 pm will be charged a full room rate. Be sure to mention USS FRANK KNOX REUNION when making reservations. PLEASE BOOK EARLY! September 26th is the cut-off date for making reservations at this rate. There is ample FREE parking for auto or RV.

### **TRANSPORTATION:**

Branson is serviced by two Springfield, MO airports, 1500 W. Kearney Street, Springfield, MO 65803-1354. Starting out going WEST on W. Kearney St./Mo 744 toward N. Bolivar R4 - .01 Mile Turn RIGHT onto MO-13N/N Kansas Expy. .06 Mi Merge onto I-44E. 4.4 mile, merge onto US 65 via EXIT 82A toward Branson. 42.9 mile Take the MO-76/76 Country Blvd/Main St. exit. .02 mile Turn LEFT onto MO 76/W76 Country Blvd/Main Street. Continue to follow MO-76/W76 Country Blvd 2.5 mile. End at Clarion Hotel at the Palace 2820 W. Highway 76, Branson, MO 65606.

OR

2546 E. Division Street, Springfield, MO 65803-5138. Start out going EAST on E. Division St. toward OLD ORCHARD AVENUE, 1 mile. Merge onto US 65-S 41 Mile. Take the MO 76/76 Country Blvd/Main Street exit. .02 mile. Turn LEFT onto MO76/W76 Country Blvd/W Main Street. Continue to follow MO76/ W76 Country Blvd. 2.5 mile. End at 2820 W. Country Blvd at Clarion Hotel at the Palace.

The Hotel does not have a shuttle service, you may want to rent a car. Vaughan Kruger has volunteered to rent a Van as will Nancy & I and transport as many to the hotel as possible. When you make your travel reservation please let us know your arrival time and we will try to coordinate pick-up. Branson is about an hour drive.

In an issue of Tin Can Sailors there is a color profile of the USS Gearing Class FRAM DDR (1960s Conversions) that states the USS Frank Knox three twin 5-in. gun mounts, two triple MK 32 torpedo tube mounts, the 5-in. gun mounts I remember as gun captain of mount 52, but during my time aboard, 1950 - 1954, we never had a single torpedo mount. Was this a conversion after 1954?
